BRINGING CHRIST

Into your home Into your family Into your life

Use the reading and reflection below to help your family better understand and dive a little deeper into this weekend's Gospel!

Think: Jesus welcomed the people. He spoke to them about God's kingdom and healed everyone who was sick. Late in the afternoon the twelve apostles came to Jesus and said, "Send the crowd to the villages and farms around here. They need to find a place to stay and something to eat. There is nothing in this place. It is like a desert!" Jesus answered, "You give them something to eat." But they replied, "We have only five small loaves of bread and two fish. If we are going to feed all these people, we will have to go and buy food." There were about five thousand men in the crowd. Jesus said to his disciples, "Have the people sit in groups of fifty." They did this, and all the people sat down. Jesus took the five loaves and two fish. He looked up toward heaven and blessed the food. Then he broke the bread and fish and handed them to his disciples to give to the people. Everyone ate all they wanted. What was left over filled 12 baskets.

Challenge: We hear in the Bible several times about Jesus blessing bread, breaking it, and sharing it with others. When we come to Mass, we come as one large family to celebrate something which happened for all of us: the Resurrection of Jesus. We share a meal together just as Jesus did with his apostles and the crowd. We believe that, through the power of God, the bread and wine become the Eucharist, the body and blood of Jesus, who gives himself to each of us in a very special way. Jesus said, "I am the bread of life," and when we share in the Eucharistic Meal, we share life with the Son of God himself. Lord Jesus, you are the living bread which comes to each one of us in a special way. Help me to share the joy of your love with others I meet. Amen.


