

Use the reading and reflection below to help your family better understand and dive a little deeper into this weekend's Gospel!


Think: Jesus chose seventy-two disciples and sent them out in pairs to all the towns and villages he would visit saying, "Take nothing with you, and wherever you are welcomed, make the first words you speak be, 'Peace be with you.' Stay if you are invited to, and eat and drink whatever you are given. Cure the sick and share the Good News of God's love with everyone. If you find people unfriendly or unkind, leave their village and go elsewhere." Soon the disciples returned and told Jesus about the marvelous things they had seen and done. Jesus said to them, "Be happy, indeed, because your names are written in heaven."

Challenge: Jesus knew that he would need help to take the message of God's love to people throughout the world. He sent the disciples out to prepare the people for him to come into their lives. What did Jesus tell the disciples to take? Jesus told them to take few belongings for their journey and to trust God to take care of them. People would see their goodness and would treat them with kindness and generosity. Jesus wanted the disciples to share the love and peace of God through their actions and words. He told them to cure the sick and to teach the people about the goodness of God, so that they would let him into their hearts. As Christians, or followers of Jesus, we take his love and peace out to the people we meet today, just as the disciples did so long ago. Lord, we pray for everyone who shares your message of love and peace with the world. Amen.
