BRINGING CHRIST

Into your home Into your family Into your life

Use the reading and reflection below to help your family better understand and dive a little deeper into this weekend's Gospel!

Think: Jesus said to his disciples: "I came to set fire to the earth, and I surely wish it were already on fire! I am going to be put to a hard test. And I will have to suffer a lot of pain until it is over. Do you think that I came to bring peace to earth? No indeed! I came to make people choose sides. A family of five will be divided, with two of them against the other three. Fathers and sons will turn against one another, and mothers and daughters will do the same. Mothers-in-law and daughters-in-law will also turn against each other."

Challenge: Luckily, Jesus wasn't saying he wanted to actually burn something in this weekend's Gospel. Many times in the Bible, Jesus spoke symbolically. In this case, fire is used as a way to purify something. Jesus wanted the people to be cleaned out of their old thoughts about God and to start thinking about Him in a new way: a way of love, forgiveness, and kindness toward God and one another. He wanted to show them that God could be known to them personally. By teaching in this way, Jesus knew that some people would accept this new way of being with God and some people would not. The difference between these ways of thinking is where the fighting in this Gospel reading began. Our Church teaches that tensions among people are inevitable. However, there is always hope. God's grace shines like a beacon of peace and strengthens us while we journey together. God is goodness itself and he loves those who share his goodness with others by their words or actions. He will surround them with his love and always watch over them. (Psalm 11:7)
