


Dear Parishioners of St. Patrick Church of Merna,

As we are gearing up for our parish's capital campaign, it is a fitting time for our parishioners to take a closer look at our parish's overall financial health. Below is a document detailing our income and expenses. I would like to give perspective and highlight a few details. When Covid hit, collections at many churches of all denominations dropped significantly. However, due to your generosity to our Increased Offertory Program, collections at St. Mary's stayed relatively steady through the fiscal years 2019-20 with \$175,046 and 2020-21 with \$171,588, while Sunday Collections for the fiscal year 2021-22 totaled \$217,772 - up 27% from the prior year!!! This increase in funds allowed our parish to make some needed improvements at our parish. I would also like to draw attention to the Capital Improvement Fund. This fund was created years ago as a means to collect money in order to pay off our remaining debt from the parking lot. With that debt retired, this fund can now be used to help pay for capital improvements at our parish. Thanks to your continued generosity, we can ensure the care of St. Mary Church in Downs for many years to come.
